



## Cider Press Rental Agreement 2022

*Thank you for contacting City Fruit to use our community cider press! Our three presses are available for neighbors to divert fruit waste and create family or community-building events.*

**Rental period.** Cider presses are rented for 1-7 days, depending on need and when the next rental may be. Community members indicate the minimum number of days they wish to have the press for and which day(s) they plan to press so that delivery to and from can be coordinated. [Rentals usually are from Sun-Fri; Fri-Sat; or Sat-Sun.]

**Cleaning, pickup, and delivery.** A press is delivered to you clean, and then you should deliver the press clean to the next neighbor or community organization (within Seattle metropolitan area) renting it. Please see attached cleaning instructions. This is a neighbor-to-neighbor exchange. Please respect your neighbors by coordinating the best time/instructions to deliver and drop off.

- If you are beyond the Seattle metropolitan area, you are responsible for both pickup and delivery.
- We recommend that 2 people move the presses in and out of vehicles. They can be heavy!

**Rental Fees.** We want all community members to be able to use our cider presses! For this reason, there is no cost to borrow a press. We do encourage donations if it is easily affordable so that we continue to host/repair presses. We suggest a \$50-100 contribution for a 1-7 day period. **Safety and usage.** City Fruit is not responsible for any manufacturing defects in any borrowed cider presses or any damage to vehicles used to transport the presses. Should the press become unsafe or in a state of disrepair while in your care, please immediately discontinue use of the tool and notify City Fruit of the issue as soon as possible and especially before it goes to the next community member. Borrowers are expected to be familiar with using presses and if not, then please review relevant instructional videos.

**Responsibility for damage.** Cider presses are to be returned in the same condition as they were issued, barring normal wear and tear. If a press is damaged due to improper use, you are asked to help fix or help cover the cost of fixing the damage. If the press is destroyed, lost, or unfixable, then you are asked to help replace it.
